The Town Council of Gurley, Alabama, met on February 5, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. in the Gurley Town Hall for a regular meeting.

Upon roll call, present were Bill Dear, Robert Winn, Robert Sentell, Gary Boyett, Dorothy Johnson and Andrew Whitten. Mayor Sentell declared a quorum and called the meeting to order.

A motion was made by Dear, seconded by Whitten, to dispense with the reading and approve, as prepared, the Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on January 15, 2019. On voice vote, motion carried.

Consent Agenda:
