**Regular Meeting:**

The Town Council of Gurley, Alabama, met on March 15, 2022, at 7:00 p.m. in the Gurley Town Hall for a regular meeting.

Mayor Simpson called the regular meeting to order. Upon roll call, present were Richard Meyers, Robert Winn, Gary Boyett, Joseph Belles and Stan Simpson.

**Reading of Minutes:** A motion was made by Winn, seconded by Meyers, to dispense with the reading and approve as prepared, the Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on March 1, 2022. On voice vote, motion carried.

**Miscellaneous Reports:**

Robert L. Tucker, III and Philip Kelly from Tucker, Smith & Associates, P.C. gave a report on the Audit for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 2021.

**Public Comments:**

No comments.

**Reports of Officers:**

- a) **Police Department:** Body cameras have been issued and are in use. We are in a “learning phase” with them. The equipment list has been submitted to Feniex (the lighting company for our new emergency lighting) and should receive confirmation and estimated delivery date this week. Condolences to the Brad Thompson family.

**Hearings of Petitions. Applications. Complaints. Appeals. Communications. etc.:**

1. **Stan Simpson-Mayor: Review of the Park Lighting bids. We only received one bid.** We have 30 days to negotiate to see if we like it and to look it over. Considering doing it in phases.
2. **Robert Winn-Council Place 2:** There is a dog running up & down the road without a leash that needs to be checked out.

**Resolutions. Ordinances. Orders and other business:**

- a) **Approval for Expenditures:** A motion was made by Boyett, seconded by Belles to approve the payment of the expenditures. Motion carried on voice vote.
- b) **Air Conditioning Bids:** A motion was made by Belles, seconded by Boyett to accept the bid from Williams Air Conditioning for \$11,800.00 on the air conditioning bids. Motion carried on voice vote.
- c) **Add Tammy Giroir to the Credit Cards:** A motion was made by Meyers, seconded by Winn to add Tammy Giroir to the credit cards. Motion carried on voice vote.
- d) **Authorize Mayor to enter contract for Fire Hydrant Testing:** A motion was made by Meyers, seconded by Boyett to authorize Mayor Simpson to enter into a contract for Fire Hydrant Testing: Councilman Belles reported that we have 104 fire hydrants that are within the Fire District. We would hire a 3<sup>rd</sup> party company to do the testing on all the hydrants this year and they would let us know of any repairs that need to be made. We would still be responsible for painting the Fire Hydrants. Motion carried on voice vote.
- e) **Donations of \$360.00 to the Police Department:** A motion was made by Meyers, seconded by Winn to accept the \$100.00 donation from Mr. Davis and \$260.00 from another contributor. Motion carried on voice vote.

- f) **North Alabama Deaf Association to use Charles Stone Park on April 9, 2022:**  
A motion was made by Belles, seconded by Meyers to approve for the North Alabama Deaf Association to use Charles Stone Park on April 9, 2022 for a picnic and meeting. Motion carried on voice vote.

All Council Members received a copy of the February 2022 Financials.
