The Town Council of Gurley, Alabama, met on April 16, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. in the Gurley Town Hall for a regular meeting.

Upon roll call, present were Bill Dear, Robert Winn, Robert Sentell, Gary Boyett, Dorothy Johnson and Andrew Whitten. Mayor Sentell declared a quorum and called the meeting to order.

A motion was made by Whitten, seconded by Winn, to dispense with the reading and approve, as prepared, the Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on April 2, 2019. On voice vote, motion carried.

Consent Agenda:
