

**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-001**

**AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT REGULATIONS AND A REVISED SCHEDULE OF WATER AND SEWER RATES, CHARGES, AND FEES TO BE CHARGED BY THE TOWN OF GURLEY, ALABAMA, AND TO REPEAL ANY INCONSISTENT PRIOR ORDINANCES**

WHEREAS, the Town of Gurley, Alabama is authorized to own and establish rates and charges related to the use of a water system and a sanitary sewer system, pursuant to Ala. Code §11-50-1 and §11-50-121 et seq., respectively; and

WHEREAS, the Town has invested in development of water and sanitary sewer systems to serve the needs of its residential and commercial customers; and

WHEREAS, the Town last amended its schedule of charges for water and sewer services provided by the Town in Ordinance 2017-005, adopted on October 3, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Town finds it necessary and advisable to further revise the schedule of rates for water and sewer services provided by the Town and to establish other regulations and procedures related to provision of water and sewer service; and

WHEREAS, the Town finds it desirable to consolidate all of its rates and other regulations relating to provision of water and sewer service in one ordinance and to repeal all previous ordinances relating to such service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Gurley that the following schedule of rates, fees, and charges and related regulations and procedures is adopted as of the effective date stated below:

**ARTICLE I. WATER SERVICE**

**SECTION 1.1. WATER RATES.**

The Town hereby establishes a schedule of monthly rates for water service from the Town’s water system as shown below. The minimum charge shall apply to each single unit plus the commodity charge for usage above the minimum. Where a single meter serves multiple residential or commercial units, the base rate shall apply to each unit regardless of occupancy. The base rate for multiple units served by a common meter includes 2,000 gallons times the number of units served by a common meter.

- (b) Determination of size of meters to be required for all such new water service installations, and the required type of backflow preventer, for purposes of applying the schedule adopted in this section, shall be within the sole discretion of the Town.
- (c) Service provided upon payment of the water installation service charges outlined in the schedule in Section 1.3(a) above will include tapping the main, installing a corporation stop, installing a meter box and service line to a point adjacent to the customer's property line within a dedicated right-of-way or easement, and installation of the appropriate meter and backflow preventer if deemed necessary or advisable, including the cost of the meter and backflow preventer.

**SECTION 1.4. METER SET; WATER SERVICE FEES**

- (a) There is hereby imposed the following schedule of water service fees (by meter size) for setting a meter for new service where the main has been tapped and service lines previously installed to customer's property line:

- (b) Determination of size of meters to be required for all such new meter installations shall be within the sole discretion of the Town.
- (c) Service provided upon payment of the service charges outlined in the schedule in Section 1.4(a) above will include only installation of the necessary meter and backflow preventer, if deemed necessary or advisable.

## **ARTICLE II. WASTEWATER DISPOSAL SERVICE**

### **SECTION 2.1. WASTEWATER DISPOSAL RATES**

The Town hereby establishes a schedule of monthly rates for wastewater disposal service by the sanitary sewer system of the Town based on water usage as shown below. Rates for residential sewer disposal shall apply to any customer to whom residential water rates apply. Commercial sewer disposal rates shall apply to provision of sewer disposal services to all other customers of the Town. The minimum charge shall apply to each single unit plus the commodity charge for usage above the minimum. Where a single meter serves multiple residential or commercial units, the base rate shall apply to each unit regardless of occupancy. The base rate for multiple units served by a common meter includes 2,000 gallons times the number of units served by a common meter.

- <sup>1</sup> The minimum charge is based on water flow through the customer's meter up to 2,000 gallons on a per month per meter basis.
- <sup>2</sup> The commodity charge is based on water flow through the customer's meter in amounts over the 2,000 gallons included in the minimum charge. The charge is per month per meter per 1,000 gallons.
- <sup>3</sup> The commodity charge for sewer does not apply for water flow through irrigation meters.
- <sup>4</sup> The rates automatically change to the new rate on January 1 of that year, except where otherwise authorized.

**SECTION 2.2. ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS RELATED TO WASTEWATER DISPOSAL RATES**

- (a) Secondary Meters. The schedule of rates established above shall be inapplicable and shall not serve as a basis for calculating a wastewater disposal service charge for water supplied through a secondary (irrigation) meter installed by the Town to provide water not serviced by the Gurley Sanitary Sewer System.
- (b) Mandatory Charge. The foregoing schedule of wastewater disposal rates shall be charged and imposed against any customer connected with the sanitary sewer system and any residence or business establishment required by law to be connected to the sanitary sewer system, whether or not such establishment has actually been connected with the sanitary sewer system as required.

**SECTION 2.3. NEW WASTEWATER DISPOSAL SYSTEM INSTALLATION SERVICE (TAP) CHARGES**

- (a) There is hereby imposed the following schedule of new wastewater disposal system installation service (tap) charges (by type of installation) for new wastewater disposal service installations:

<u>Type of Installation</u>	<u>Amount</u>
Residential (for each single-family residence tapped to sewer)	\$750.00 Plus material costs
Commercial (all other taps to sewer, including apartment complex and other multifamily residential connections)	Actual estimated cost of labor and materials plus 30%

- (b) The Town may establish such reasonable guidelines as it deems necessary for determining, in its sole discretion, the type of installation required and the actual estimated costs of labor and material for residential/commercial taps.
- (c) Services provided upon payment of the wastewater disposal system installation service charges outlined in Section 2.3(a) above will include all services necessary to tap the sewer line in a dedicated easement or right-of-way and to make a connection between such sewer line and a service line provided and installed by the customer.

### ARTICLE III. GENERAL PROVISIONS

#### SECTION 3.1. MISCELLANEOUS FEES, AND CHARGES

There is hereby imposed the following miscellaneous fees, and charges for services provided by the Town.

(a) New Water Account Charge *	30.00
(b) Fire Protection Services Per Inch of Service Line:

#### SECTION 3.2. LEAK ADJUSTMENT POLICY

The purpose of the Town of Gurley Water Leak Adjustment policy is to provide the customer with relief from an unusually high water bill resulting from a water supply line failure. The Billing Office will make an adjustment to a customer's water bill according to this policy. To receive a billing adjustment due to a leak, the following conditions must be met:

1. The leak has to be in the customer's supply line (in the yard or underneath the house). Leaking fixtures, malfunctioning appliances, running faucets, and similar situations do not qualify for a leak adjustment.
2. The Town of Gurley will only go back two months for a leak adjustment. Also, if it is a large leak, the water will be turned off after the second month until the leak is fixed. Our office will adjust for the first two (2) months after the leak was discovered.

3. An employee of the water department must verify the location and nature of the leak and verify that the leak was repaired.

Adjustments to the water bill will be based on “historic usage” of the customer over the previous 6 months, which shall reflect seasonal or other historic patterns. If the customer does not have at least six (6) months of previous bills to establish historical usage, then the adjustment will be based on the available data, which can include similar customers. The past usage for six (6) months is divided by 6 to arrive at an average monthly usage. The average total is then subtracted from the gallons used during the month the leak occurred. This usage is not considered the leak amount and is billed according to our tariff. For large leaks, a payment plan can be set up if the customer desires.

### **SECTION 3.3. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances previously adopted by the Town in conflict herewith, including but not limited to Ordinances 255, 264, 266R1, 269, 275, Ordinance 299, 2013-003R1 and Ordinance 2017-005 are repealed as of the effective date of this ordinance.

### **SECTION 3.4. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Ordinance and the rates, fees, and charges set out herein shall become effective immediately on passage.
